

## Using a Nook or other ePub compatible device

### Get Adobe Digital Editions

Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) is required to download eBooks that are in ePub or ePdf format. Download Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) to your computer. The download and instructions for ADE is on the OverDrive website <http://dbooks.wplc.info> in the lower left hand corner under **Software**.

### Activate ADE

ADE must be activated with an Adobe ID if you wish to download and read eBooks on multiple computers and transfer them to supported eBook devices.

### Find ePub material

Find an eBook in OverDrive and add it to your cart checkout. An Advanced search allow you to limit selection to ePub material only.

## Nook, continued

### Checkout the material in your cart

Click on my cart and then Proceed to Check-out. Enter your library system: Waukesha County Federated Library System and your library card number from the back of your card. Choose your lending period and confirm your check out.

### Download to your computer

Download your eBook to your computer. This will open ADE and you will see the book in the *Borrowed* folder under *Bookshelves*.

### Transfer to your Nook

(or other ePub compatible device)  
Connect the Nook to your computer. ADE will recognize it and list it under *Bookshelves*. (You may be prompted to enter your Adobe ID and Password) Under *Bookshelves*, click on *Borrowed*, find your book in the right pane and drag it to *Nook* (in the left pane). Disconnect the Nook from the computer and read the book by accessing it through My Library and My Documents.

### Check in early

In ADE, click the arrow near the book title for item options Selection *Return Borrowed item* to check it in. All eBooks are automatically checked-in at the end of the check-out period.

## eBooks from the Library

eBooks are available from the library for supported eReaders through our digital content provider, **OverDrive**. eBooks are noted in the Library catalog as *OverDrive* books that are Downloadable via the Internet. All you need to get started is a computer with an Internet connection, a supported eReader or App, and your library card.

## Find OverDrive material

Search for eBooks through the Library catalog at [www.pewaukeelibrary.org](http://www.pewaukeelibrary.org). Click on the Catalog link. Do an advanced search for the *Downloadable Book* type; or Click the link on our webpage under the Stay Informed section to go directly to OverDrive's Digital Download Center at <http://dbooks.wplc.info>

## Getting Started with your Kindle

### Find Kindle compatible material

In OverDrive, it's easiest to find Kindle-compatible material through an advanced search found on the left side bar. Click *Formats* and select Kindle. You can also limit your search to include only material that is available for checkout. Add your selections to the cart.

## Kindle, continued

### Checkout the material in your cart

Enter your library system: *Waukesha County Federated Library System* and your library card number from the back of your card. Choose your lending period and confirm your check out. Click Get for Kindle.

### Sign in to Amazon

The Kindle Store page on the Amazon website should appear with your library title. Click **Get Library Book**. If you're not signed into Amazon, you must sign into your account. (If you do not have an Amazon account you must create one. This does not require a credit card or payment.)

### Choose eBook Delivery

Select where you'd like your eBook Delivered. Your registered devices will appear here such as your Kindle or a Kindle app on your PC or other device.

### Download To Your Device

Sync your device to the computer or connect your device to wireless internet. The device will automatically download your selections.

### Manage Your Kindle

Log into your Amazon account and go the Manage My Kindle page to see what you have checked out and to return items early. Use the Actions button by the item to return your eBook early or send it to another device.

Amazon will send you an email reminding you of when your item is due.

You can place a hold on a digital item that is currently checked out by clicking *Place a Hold* and entering your email address. You will be notified via email when the item is available for you.

All eBooks are checked in automatically.

Any software or app needed to used OverDrive digital content is free. See the OverDrive website for download information.

Use of digital material through the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium and your local library is free. You may receive purchase messages from Amazon regarding Kindle material but these do not affect the terms of your library download.
