




Elatsoe

by Jennifer A. Nielsen


In the country of Carthya, a devious nobleman engages four orphans in a brutal competition to be selected to impersonate the king's long-missing son in an effort to avoid a civil war.

by Garth Nix



by Brandon Sanderson


A young chalkmaker's son longs to join the ranks of future Rithmatists capable of infusing life into Chalking figures that protect humanity from Wild Chalking predators.





by Tomi Adeyemi



by Leigh Bardugo



by Jessica Cluess



by Tracy Deonn



by Sarah Fine



by Rachel Hartman



by Sara B. Larson


