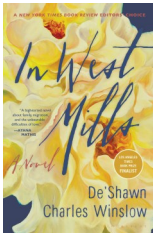

by Ocean Vuong

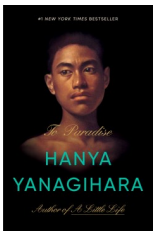
A letter from a son to a mother who cannot read reveals the impact of the Vietnam War on their family history and provides a view into parts of the son's life that his mother has never known.

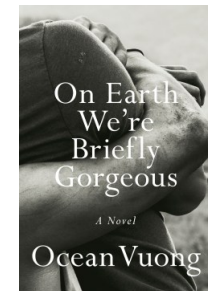
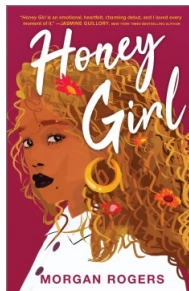
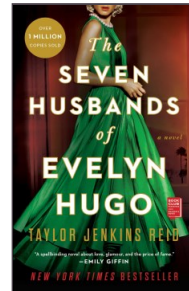
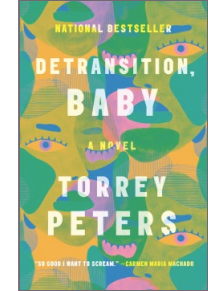
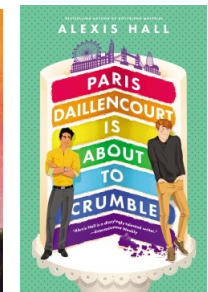
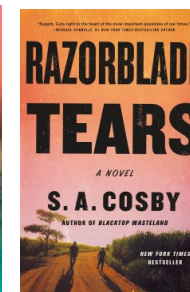
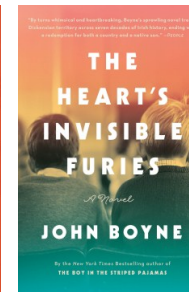
### To paradise

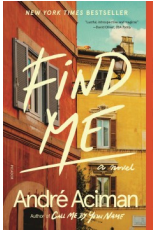

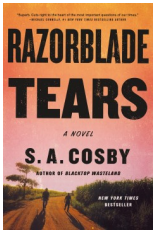

by John Boyne

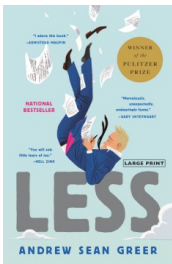

by S. A. Cosby

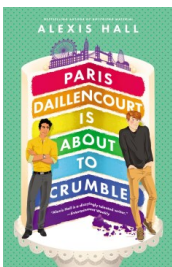

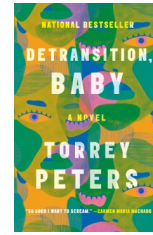

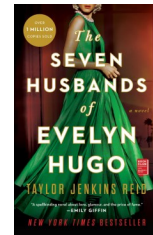
