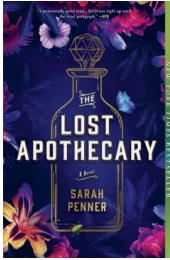




### Take my hand

by Chanel Cleeton

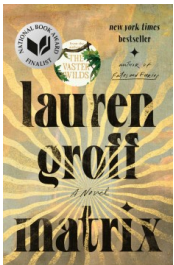

by Fiona Davis

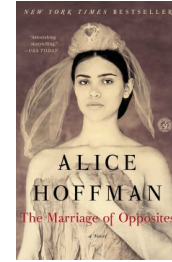

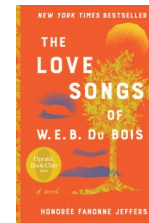


## Fast girls : a novel of the 1936 women's Olympic team

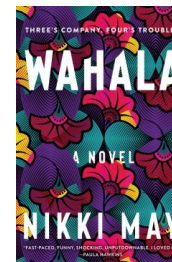
achieve.
