their real feelings for each other.

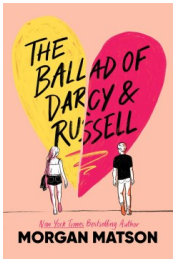


### Better than the movies

one day.

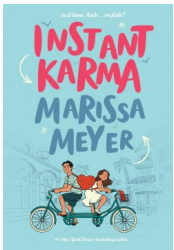


### Chaos theory

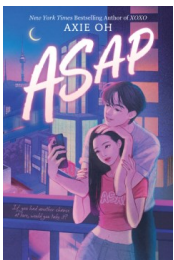
Quint Erickson, her slacker of a lab partner.

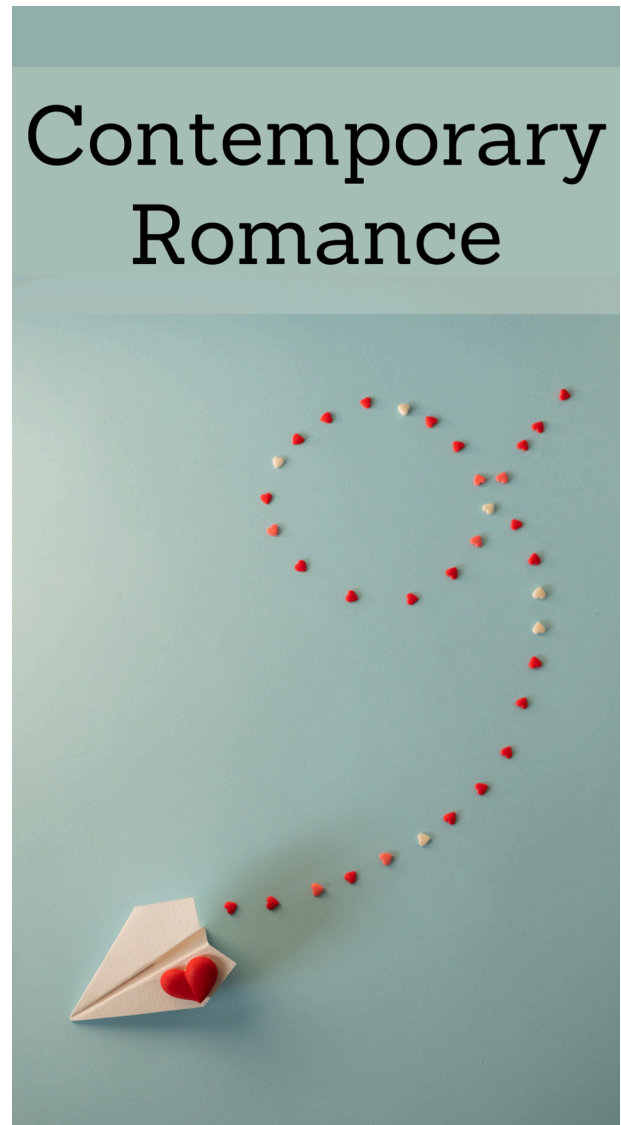


### ASAP

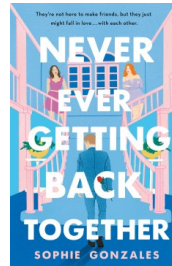
