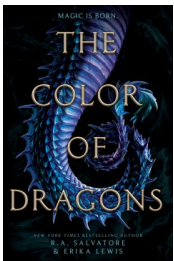


This golden flame

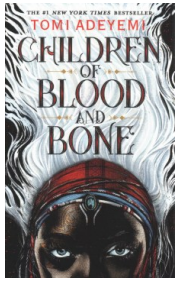

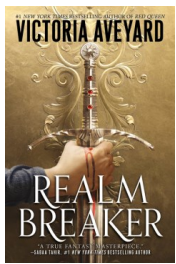

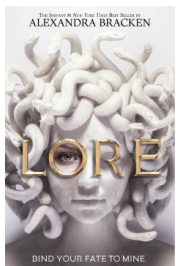
Children of blood and bone

Kindling

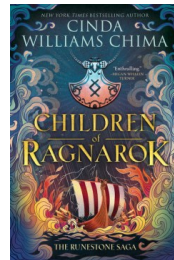
by Traci Chee
