Sophia must study the trail of clues Layla - not missing - has left behind, returning to the very place where it all began.

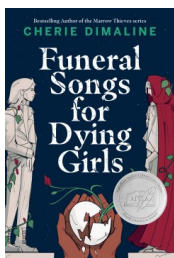


Eat your heart out

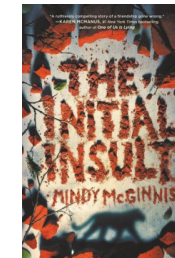
community for decades.
