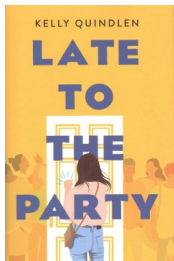
worlds above water intact?

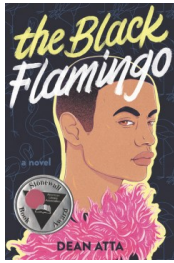

from again.

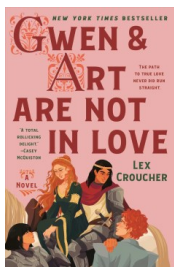


Felix ever after

charismatic new friend.

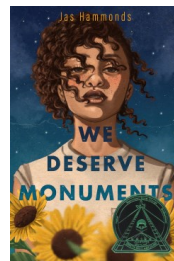


The summer of bitter and sweet

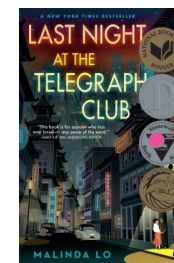


Fake dates and mooncakes
