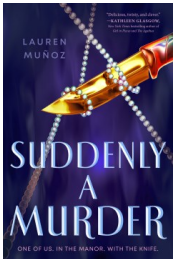


The perfect place to die

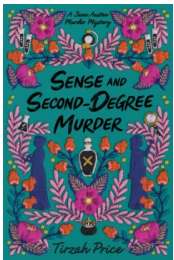
death trap.

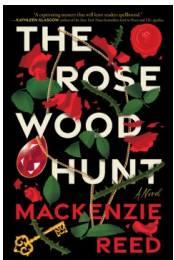


Sense and second-degree murder

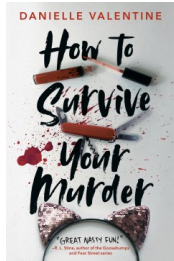
around Rosetown.

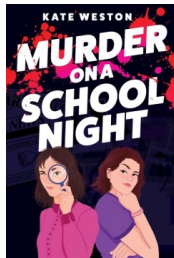


How to survive your murder

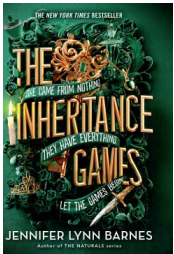


Queen of the tiles

about to face.

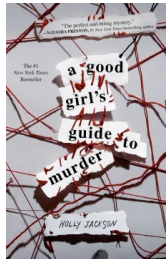


The red palace

Five years after the shattering murder and suicide of two popular teens, a skeptical high school student reexamines the case before uncovering clues about what really happened.

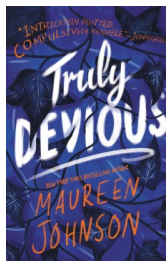


Monday's not coming
