A collection of six short stories imagines future lands brimming with new technologies and beings, where in spite of advanced

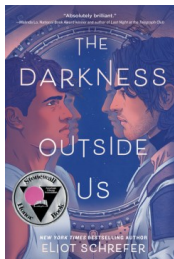
capabilities, people are forced to confront deeply troubling human problems.

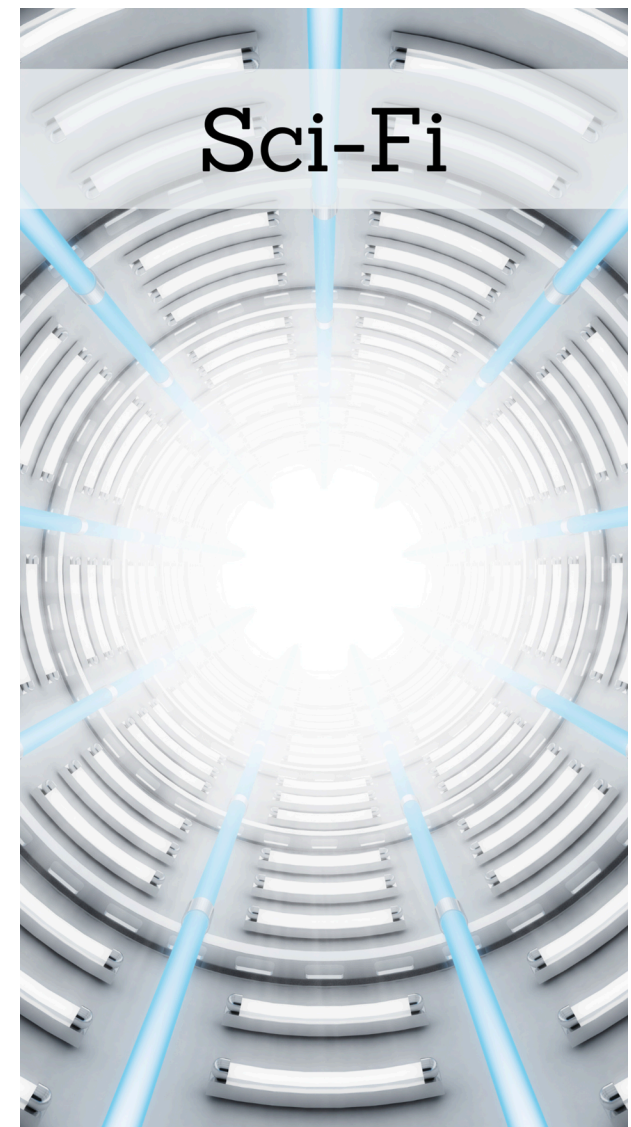


Iron widow

by E. K. Johnston

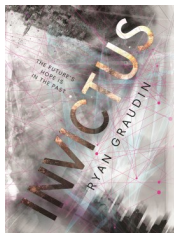
