sky, which comes at a high price.

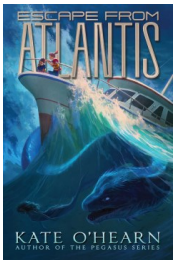


## The kingdom over the sea

by Kate O'Hearn

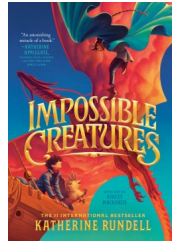

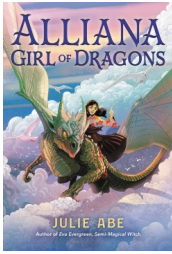

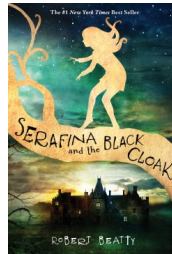


## Twinchantment

Living secretly in the basement of a grand estate where her pa works as a maintenance man, young Serafina narrowly escapes a black-cloaked man who has

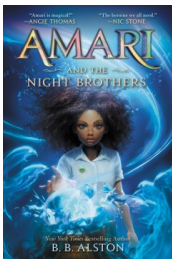
been abducting local children and who Serafina, aided by a youth from the estate, endeavors to expose.

by Deva Fagan

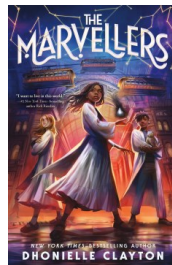
Pia Paro questions the system she once believed in and joins the Seafoxes, a ragtag team of players seeking to win the deadly Noctis games, to save her grandfather

disappears.

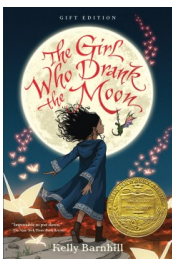


## The accidental apprentice

inadvertently bonded to a not-so-vicious magical beast.

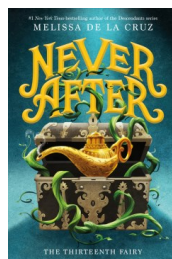


## The girl who drank the moon
