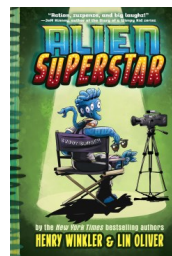


The Truth about 5th grade

has shared her most secretest secret while Alex tries to figure out why Charlotte's no longer talking to him.

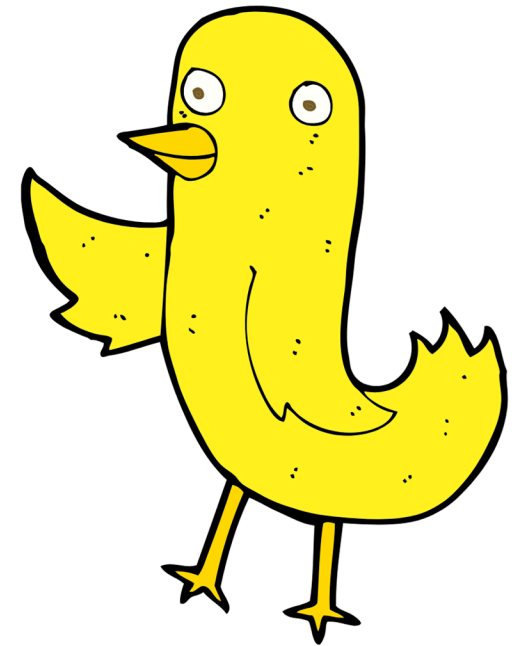


Alien superstar
