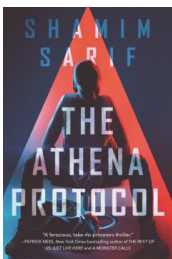

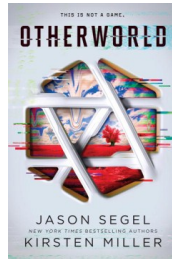
Skyward

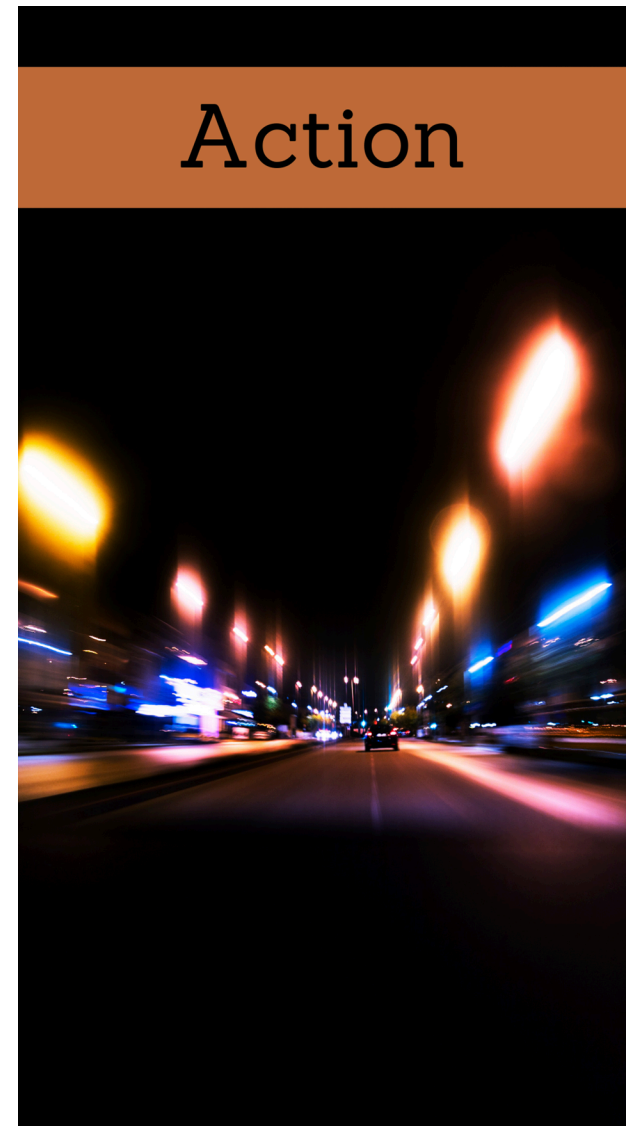
The rule of one

by Burton, Gabi

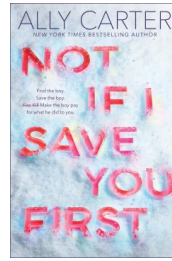

by Rae Carson

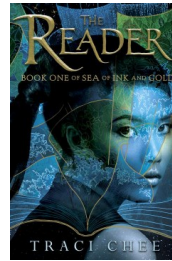
Waking up from a deadly illness to a world that has perished, Paige Miller struggles to endure her new reality and learns that there are worse things than being alone.

by Chee, Traci

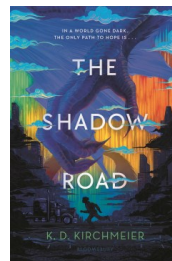
