performances and a parent's failing health.

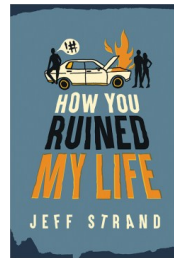


### The lake effect

Rod's life is going well until his rich, prankster cousin, Blake, moves in for three months - moving into his room and moving in on his girlfriend and band - ruining everything.

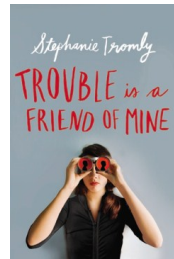


### The life and (medieval) times of Kit Sweetly

into Internet fame and a whole lot of trouble.

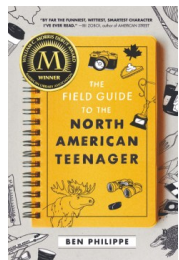


### Trouble is a friend of mine

students as clichés from "a bad 90s teen movie."



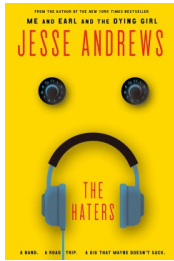

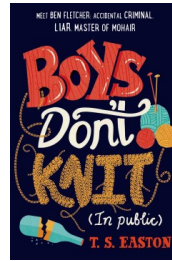
the darkest yet.

that helps him deal with his anxieties.

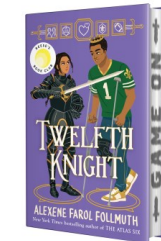


## How to date a superhero (and not die trying)

double life.

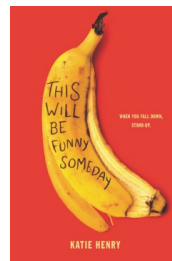


## Twelfth knight

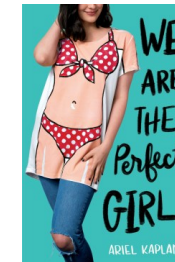
