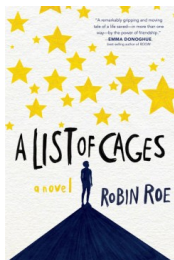
appearing all over town.

by Ritter, William

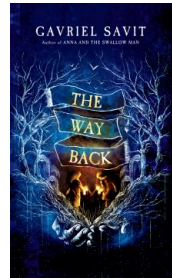

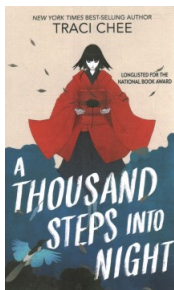
place in Drag Society.

by T. E. Carter

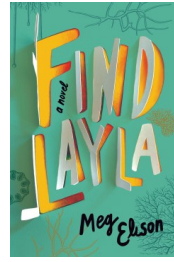

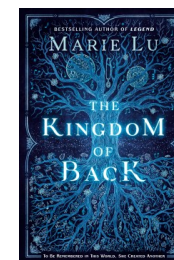


Cold the night, fast the wolves
