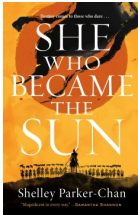




## The bone orchard

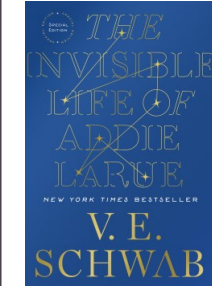
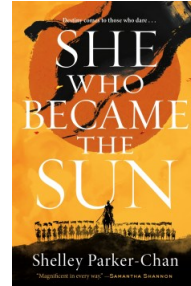
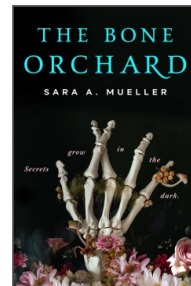
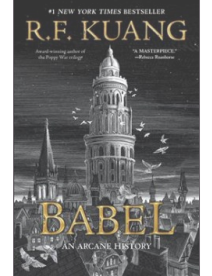
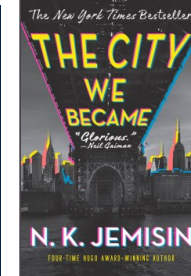
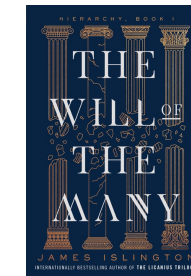
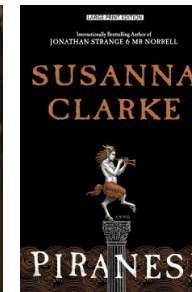
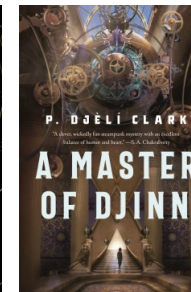
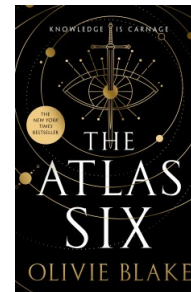
## The invisible life of Addie LaRue
