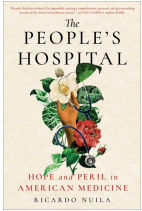

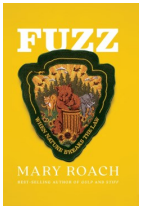


The people's hospital : hope and peril in American medicine
