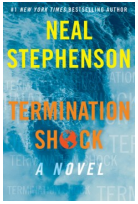

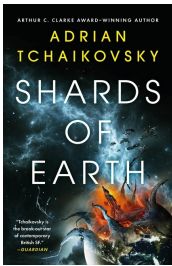

by Adrian Tchaikovsky

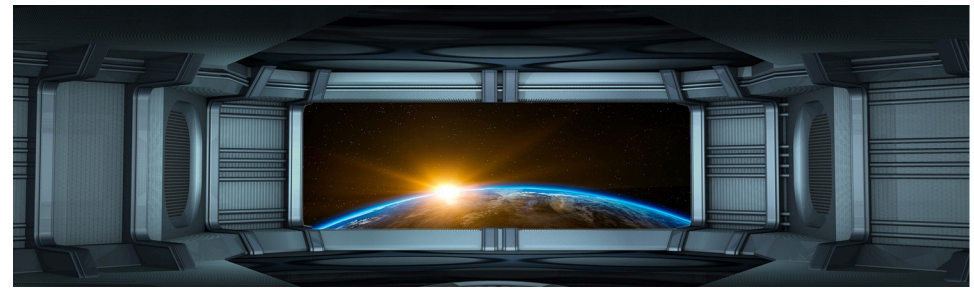

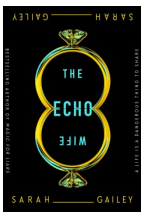


The last watch

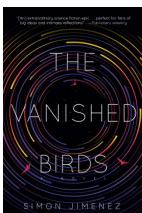
grandfather's genetics facility for "reasons." She knows they're humanity's last chance"

by Simon Jimenez

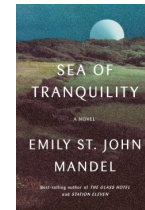

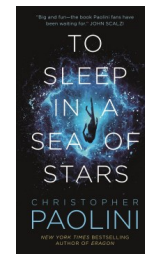
