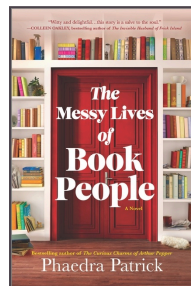
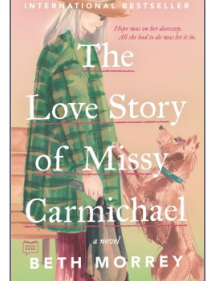
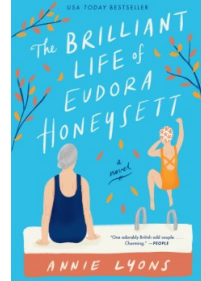
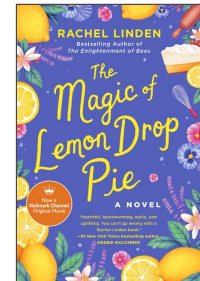
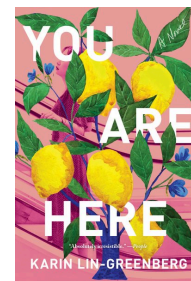
Miss Cecily's recipes for exceptional ladies : a novel

by Sara Nisha Adams

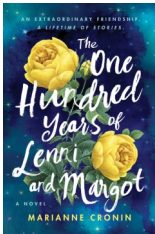

by Marianne Cronin

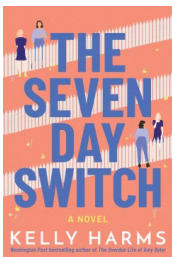

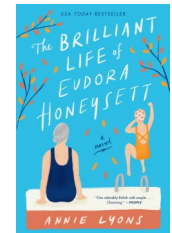

by Rachel Linden

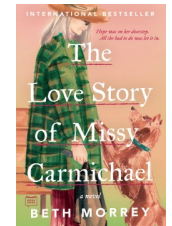

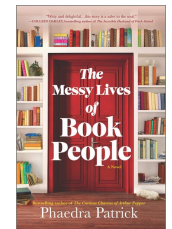
